National affairs

- 1. Chhattisgarh Chief Minister Bishnu Deo Sai laid the foundation stone of India's first AI-Based Data Centre Park in Nava Raipur.
- 2. Goldsikka unveiled India's first AI-powered Gold Melting ATM.
- 3. 8th National Community Radio Conference was held in Mumbai. The conference was jointly organized by the Union Ministry of Information & Broadcasting and the Indian Institute of Mass Communication (IIMC).
- 4. India became the first country in the world to develop a genetically modified rice variety.
- 5. UK-India Minister Lisa Nandy signed the India-UK Cultural Pact in Delhi.
- 6. Rajasthan agreed to join India's first Inter-State Cheetah Conservation Corridor with Madhya Pradesh.
- 7. 72nd Miss World 2025 will be held in Hyderabad, Telangana.
- 8. The Indian government will host the 12th Global Space Exploration Conference (GLEX 2025) in New Delhi.
- 9. Indian Institute of Foreign Trade to open Off-Campus Centre in GIFT City, Gujarat. (Off-campus centre is a branch of a university, located outside the main campus, providing educational opportunities to students from different areas or locations. These centres usually offer the same type of programs and curriculum as the main campus, making it more accessible and convenient for students).
- 10. Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis announced the creation of India's first EduCity in Navi Mumbai. (New York University (UK), University of Western Australia (Australia) and other renowned universities will set up their campuses here).
- 11. Tamil Nadu state government has declared May 5 as Traders Day. On this day, Chief Minister M.K. Stalin introduced new welfare measures and policy changes to improve the ease of doing business in the state and provide social security for traders.
- 12. Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI) has signed an MoU with Rhenus Logistics to increase the transport of goods on national waterways across India.
- 13. India has launched Chip-Based E-Passports to ensure travel security for tourists.
- 14. The civil defence mock drill conducted in Bengaluru to strengthen emergency preparedness has been named Operation Abhyas.
- 15. President Droupadi Murmu inaugurated the 1st National Mediation Conference 2025 in New Delhi.
- 16. Northeast India's first geothermal production well has been drilled in Arunachal Pradesh.

- 3. Salem Saleh Bin Braik appointed as new Prime Minister of Yemen. (Yemen's capital is Sanaa).
- 4. Friedrich Merz, leader of the Christian Democratic Union (CDU) party, was sworn in as the new Chancellor of Germany.
- 5. India signed a Historic Free Trade Agreement with the UK.
- 6. Mike Waltz nominated as the next US Ambassador to the UN.
- 7. 58th ADB Annual Meeting held in Milan, Italy.
- 8. United Arab Emirates declared Artificial Intelligence (AI) as a mandatory subject in all classes in schools.
- 9. Iran has developed a new Solid-Fuel Ballistic Missile named 'Ghassem Basir'.

- 10. Australia launched the world's largest battery-powered ship. The ship has been named 'China Zorrilla'.
- 11. Bhutan signed an MoU with Adani Group for a 5,000 MW hydroelectric project.
- 12. Global cybersecurity event "GISEC Global 2025" is being held in Dubai.
- 13. Vietnam has launched a 10-year Golden Visa program for Indian investors and tourists.
- 14. India has signed Terms of Reference (TOR) with Chile for the Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA).
- 15. Cardinal Robert Prevost has been elected as the Pope of the Roman Catholic Church. He is the first American to become Pope.
- 16. 10th International Trade Fair has started in Nepal.
