National affairs

1. Union Home Minister Amit Shah inaugurated the Central Forensic Science Lab in Kolkata, the capital of West Bengal.
2. Recently, the Khichan and Menar wetlands of Rajasthan were granted Ramsar site status.
3. Himachal Pradesh declared Raja Khas as the first solar model village in the state.
4. Union Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan launched the 'Viksit Krishi Sankalp Abhiyan' in Puri, Odisha.
5. A national conference on AI for empowering people with disabilities was held in Bengaluru.
6. 34 digital courts were inaugurated in New Delhi.
7. The center declared the area around Tral Wildlife Sanctuary in Jammu and Kashmir as an Eco-Sensitive Zone.
8. Indian Oil Corporation (IOCL) will set up India's largest Green Hydrogen Plant in Panipat, Haryana.
9. The Telangana government has declared Kawal Tiger Corridor as Kumram Bheem Conservation Reserve.
10. Maharashtra will start basic military training for first-grade students.
11. Maharashtra is the largest blueberry producing state in India.
12. India has been elected as the President of the International Institute of Administrative Sciences (IIAS) for 2025-28.
13. Telangana's Kumaram Bhim has been declared a new tiger reserve.
14. Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (IICA) to open its first North-Eastern regional campus in Shillong, Meghalaya.
15. President Droupadi Murmu promulgated the Ladakh Official Language Control Act, 2025. The Act amends the Act to reserve one-third of the seats for women in the Ladakh Hill Council.
16. Indian Army launches 'Operation Shiva'.

International affairs

1. Luís Montenegro was reappointed as Prime Minister of Portugal. (Portugal's capital is Lisbon).
2. Lee Jae-myung was sworn in as the new President of South Korea. (South Korea's capital is Seoul).
3. Germany surpassed Japan to become the world's largest creditor country.
4. Nicaragua accepted the Fisheries Subsidy Agreement as the 101st member of the World Trade Organization (WTO).
5. Dick Schoof recently resigned as Prime Minister of the Netherlands. (The capital of the Netherlands is Amsterdam).
6. Sheikh Mujibur Rahman's name has been removed from the new currency notes of Bangladesh.

1. Eminent economist and former Independent Director of Axis Bank S Mahendra Deb has been appointed as the new Chairman of the Economic Advisory Council to the Prime Minister of India.
2. Air Marshal Jasbir Singh Mann has been appointed as the Senior Air Staff Officer of the Western Air Command of the Indian Air Force.
3. Lieutenant Commander Yashasvi Solanki has become the first woman officer of the Indian Navy to be appointed as Aide-de-Camp (ADC) to the President of India.

5. Reserve Bank of India Deputy Governor T Ravi Shankar has joined the 16th Finance Commission as a part-time member. He will hold this post till October 31, 2025.

7. Rajiv Memani has taken charge as the President of the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) for 2025-26.

3. World Food Safety Day is celebrated on June 7; 2025 theme - "Food Safety: Science in Action."

Sports

1. India won a total of 24 medals at the Asian Athletics Championship 2025 and is at the second place in the medal table.
2. South African cricketer Heinrich Klaasen recently announced his retirement from international cricket.
3. Australian player Glenn Maxwell recently announced his retirement from ODI cricket.
4. India's Mona Agarwal won the silver medal in the women's P2 -10m Air Pistol SH1 event at the 2025 Para Shooting World Cup.

5. Norway Chess 2025 title won by Norwegian chess grandmaster Magnus Carlsen.
6. South African cricketer Chloe Tryon won the ICC Women's Player of the Month Award in May 2025 and Muhammad Waseem Muhammad of the United Arab Emirates won the ICC Men's Player of the Month Award.
7. Paris Saint-Germain won its first UEFA Champions League title by defeating Inter Milan.
8. Indian chess player Dee Gukech defeated world number 1 chess player Magnus Kallorsen of Norway in the 2025 Norway Chess Tournament.
9. Women's ODI World Cup 2025 will be held in India and Sri Lanka.
